SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE ON AFFORDABLE HOUSING PERMITTING AND TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF COUNTY ORDINANCES ON HOUSING FINANCE AND DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, Hawai'i is experiencing an unprecedented housing 1 shortage, which has resulted in insufficient affordable housing 2 3 for the State's residents; and 4 5 WHEREAS, in 2020, Continuums of Care reported that over six thousand residents of Hawai'i, including nearly five hundred 6 families, were experiencing homelessness; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, in 2019, the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism issued a report estimating that the 10 State could need an additional forty-six thousand new housing 11 12 units between 2020 and 2030; and 13 14 WHEREAS, to meet Hawai'i's demand for new housing units, 15 additional affordable housing developments will be necessary; 16 and 17 18 WHEREAS, any solution to the State's housing crisis requires the adoption, application, and enforcement of policies 19 that address county-level barriers to housing finance and 20 21 development; and 22 WHEREAS, additional information on the effect of county 23 ordinances on the operations of the Hawaii Housing Finance and 24 Development Corporation is necessary to promote greater access 25 to affordable housing; and 26 27 28 WHEREAS, the permitting processes for affordable housing 29 developments differ among the agencies and departments with jurisdiction over affordable housing development; and 30
