SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS, ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, AND TOURISM AND DEPARTMENT OF ACCOUNTING AND GENERAL SERVICES TO CONDUCT A COST ANALYSIS STUDY REGARDING CONSOLIDATING WEST HAWAII STATE OFFICES INTO ONE COMPLEX.

1	WHEREAS, there are state offices operating in various
2 3	locations in west Hawaii; and
3 4	WHEREAS, state offices whose operations are not dependent
5	on location can be moved into one convenient area and
6	consolidated at a single location for purposes of cost
7	effectiveness, efficiency, and convenience; and

9	WHEREAS, the consolidation of state services in a single central location can improve public access to those services;
10 11	now, therefore,

13	BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first
14	Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the
15	House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
16	Business, Economic Development, and Tourism and Department of
17	Accounting and General Services are requested to conduct a cost
18 19	analysis study regarding consolidating the state offices in west Hawaii into one complex; and

21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Business,
22	Economic Development, and Tourism and Department of Accounting
23	and General Services are requested to submit a report of their
24	findings and recommendations, including any proposed
25	legislation, to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior
26	to the convening of the Regular Session of 2023; and
