## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND PERMITTING OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO PUBLISH ON ITS WEBSITE ALL DECISIONS REGARDING WAIVERS AND VARIANCES.

WHEREAS, the Director of Planning and Permitting of the 1 City and County of Honolulu has the authority to provide 2 exceptions to building and land use requirements; and 3 4 WHEREAS, section 21-2.130, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, 5 authorizes the Director of Planning and Permitting of the City 6 and County of Honolulu to waive strict application of the 7 development or design standards of the county land use ordinance 8 chapter under specified circumstances; and 9 10 WHEREAS, section 6-1517, Revised Charter of the City and 11 County of Honolulu, authorizes the Director of Planning and 12 Permitting of the City and County of Honolulu to grant a 13 variance if application of the zoning code would create an 14 unnecessary hardship; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, the granting or denial of waivers and variances lacks transparency if documents pertaining to those decisions 18 19 are not easily accessible to members of the public; and 20 WHEREAS, the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development 21 of the Department of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism 22 produces a semi-monthly publication pursuant to section 343-3, 23 Hawaii Revised Statutes, known as "The Environmental Notice," 24 which informs the public of projects undergoing environmental 25 review in Hawaii along with shoreline, coastal zone management, 26 and federal notices; and 27 28 WHEREAS, the procedures of the Department of Planning and 29 Permitting have led to ligation in the cases of Citizens Against 30 Reckless Development v. Zoning Board of Appeals of the City and 31 32 County of Honolulu, 114 Haw. 184, 159 P.3d 143 (2007) and Unite



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Here! Local 5 v. Department of Planning and Permitting/Zoning 1 Board of Appeals, City and County of Honolulu, 145 Haw. 453, 454 2 P.3d 394 (2019); and 3 4 WHEREAS, in light of the March 2021 indictment of five 5 current or former Honolulu Department of Planning and Permitting 6 employees for allegedly accepting bribes to fast track permits. 7 and provide other special treatment, public perception of the 8 9 Department of Planning and Permitting would improve if the public could easily verify that applications for a waiver or 10 variance were granted or denied in a fair and consistent manner; 11 12 now, therefore, 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 14 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the 15 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of 16 Planning and Permitting of the City and County of Honolulu is 17 requested to publish on its website all decisions regarding 18 waivers and variances; and 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 21 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to Mayor of the City and 22 County of Honolulu and Director of Planning and Permitting of 23 the City and County of Honolulu. 24 25 26 OFFERED BY: Silline 27
