SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A SUNRISE ANALYSIS ON MANDATING HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE FOR ANNUAL MENTAL HEALTH SCREENINGS.

WHEREAS, according to the National Institute for Mental 1 Health, in 2019, approximately 51,500,000, or eighteen percent, 2 3 of adults in the United States experience a mental illness or disorder; and 4 5 6 WHEREAS, only forty-four percent of those individuals 7 received mental health services for their mental illness; and 8 9 WHEREAS, mental health issues are closely tied to physical health issues, such as increased occurrences of chronic diseases 10 including cardiovascular disease, diabetes, obesity, asthma, 11 epilepsy, and cancer; and 12 13 14 WHEREAS, mental health issues cost the United States economy close to \$200,000,000,000 in lost wages and 15 \$100,000,000,000 in health care costs; and 16 17 WHEREAS, suicide is the tenth leading cause of death in the 18 United States, costing approximately \$51,000,000,000 each year; 19 20 and 21 WHEREAS, Senate Bill No. 728, Regular Session of 2021, 22 would require health insurers and similar entities that provide 23 coverage for health care to provide coverage for annual mental 24 health screenings; and 25 26 27 WHEREAS, pursuant to section 23-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, before any legislative measure that mandates health 28 insurance coverage for specific health services, specific 29 diseases, or certain providers of health care services as part 30 31 of individual or group health insurance policies, can be

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1 considered, a concurrent resolution shall be passed that 2 designates a specific legislative bill for the Auditor to review 3 and on which to prepare a report for submission to the 4 Legislature that assesses both the social and financial effects 5 of the proposed mandated coverage under that legislative bill; 6 now, therefore, 7

8 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 9 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the 10 House of Representatives concurring, that the Auditor is 11 requested to conduct a sunrise analysis, pursuant to sections 12 23-51 and 23-52, Hawaii Revised Statutes, on mandating health 13 insurance coverage for annual mental health screenings, as 14 provided in Senate Bill No. 728, Regular Session of 2021; and 15

16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 17 submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including 18 any proposed legislation, to the Legislature no later than 19 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 20 2023; and

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 23 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and 24 Insurance Commissioner.
