SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE COUNTIES TO PRODUCE LAND USE PLANS THAT ACCOUNT FOR HOUSING PRODUCTION AND DEMAND.

1 WHEREAS, the State is currently in a housing crisis that will require an additional fifty-seven thousand affordable 2 housing units by 2025 in order to meet long-term housing 3 demands, particularly on Oahu; and 4 5 WHEREAS, in March 2015, the Department of Business, 6 Economic Development, and Tourism found that for the period of 7 2015 to 2025, the demand for additional housing units is: 8 25,847 units for the City and County of Honolulu; 19,610 units 9 for Hawaii County; 13,949 units for Maui County; and 5,287 units 10 for Kauai County; and 11 12 WHEREAS, despite this projected acute housing shortage for 13 2015 to 2025, there has been a lack of measurable progress at 14 the county level to enact policies that will stimulate housing 15 production to meet projected demand; now, therefore, 16 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 18 19 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the House of Representatives concurring, that the counties are urged 20 to produce land use plans that take into account projected acute 21 housing shortages and demand for housing production; and 22 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the counties are urged to 25 identify and remove barriers to housing development in their respective jurisdictions; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor of each county 29 and to each county's respective planning and permitting agency. 30
