## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS TO REPORT INFORMATION RELATING TO EXPENDITURES FROM THE WORKS OF ART SPECIAL FUND FOR THE CURATION AND PRESERVATION OF NATIVE HAWAIIAN ART.

WHEREAS, the first chairman of the Hawai'i State Foundation 1 on Culture and the Arts (Foundation), Pundy Yokouchi, once said, 2 3 "Art is as important as education, because art is education."; and 4 5 6 WHEREAS, much Native Hawaiian art, like its language, is displayed through oral and dance performances, which are not 7 supported through the Works of Art Special Fund; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, in the Foundation's 2019-2023 Strategic Priorities report, only one of the twelve objectives is dedicated to Native 11 12 Hawaiians; and 13 WHEREAS, under this single objective, three strategies are 14 15 listed: 16 17 (1)Strengthen relationships with Native Hawaiian community-based organizations; 18 19 20 (2) Regularly liaise with representatives from community 21 organizations serving Native Hawaiians; and 22 (3) Actively encourage, support, and acknowledge Native 23 Hawaiian culture; and 24 25 26 WHEREAS, the Foundation does not report on the need to 27 perpetuate traditional and customary practices while supporting 28 the self-determination and advancement of Native Hawaiian 29 cultural practitioners and artists; and

1 WHEREAS, the report also omits language on the need to 2 secure Native Hawaiian culture, arts, and intellectual property 3 against misappropriation and exploitation; and 4 5 WHEREAS, the inclusion of performing arts as a permissible 6 use of the Works of Art Special Fund would support halau hula 7 and other oli and mele practitioners and perpetuate Native 8 9 Hawaiian cultural practices; now, therefore, 10 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 11 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, the 12 House of Representatives concurring, that the State Foundation 13 on Culture and the Arts is requested to provide a report on the 14 total amount of funding expended from the Works of Art Special 15 Fund for the curation of art produced by an individual of Native 16 Hawaiian decent ("Native Hawaiian art"), number of Native 17 Hawaiian art pieces acquired, percentage of all works collected 18 through the Works of Art Special Fund that is Native Hawaiian 19 art, cost per Native Hawaiian art piece acquired, and percentage 20 of the cost of all works collected through the Works of Art 21 Special Fund attributed to the cost of acquiring Native Hawaiian 22 art; and 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Foundation is further 25 26 requested to submit the report to the Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 27 2023; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 30 31 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Executive Director of the State Foundation on Culture and the Arts. 32 33 34 35 OFFERED BY:
