SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII TO REPORT ON THE PAMANTASAN COUNCIL'S SYSTEMWIDE EFFORTS TO IMPROVE THE STATUS OF FILIPINOS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

1 WHEREAS, Filipinos represent one-quarter of Hawaii's population, the second largest ethnic group in the State, the 2 largest ethnicity in public schools, the third largest in 3 community colleges, and the fourth largest at four-year 4 campuses; and 5 6 WHEREAS, Filipino student representation and academic 7 performance has increased at all University of Hawaii campuses 8 and are adequately represented at the community colleges, but 9 Filipino student representation has seen a decline in transfer 10 rates to four-year campuses; and 11 12 WHEREAS, while Filipino student representation at the 13 University of Hawaii at Manoa has increased, Filipino students 14 continue to be underrepresented at the undergraduate level and 15 are significantly underrepresented in graduate and professional 16 degree programs; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, Filipino faculty are underrepresented at all University of Hawaii campuses as many faculty members are in 20 temporary positions while critical, permanent faculty positions 21 remain unfilled; and 22 23 WHEREAS, some Filipino faculty at University of Hawaii 24 campuses provided leadership and service to the State and the 25 Filipino community, which experienced one of the highest 26 percentages of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) cases and 27 deaths; and 28 29 WHEREAS, there are few Filipino-related courses such as 30 Philippine languages, Philippine studies, and Filipinos in 31 Hawaii offered at University of Hawaii campuses; and 32 33 WHEREAS, the state-funded University of Hawaii System is 34 responsible for teaching, research, and community service; 35



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1 additional programming to increase curriculum content; and 2 improvements to representation and success of Filipino faculty 3 and staff, which may also lead to an increase in the number of 4 University of Hawaii graduates of Filipino descent who can join 5 Hawaii's educated workforce and become active citizens in the 6 State; and

8 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii Pamantasan Council, 9 utilizing the Filipino word for "higher education", was formed 10 in 1987 to review the status of Filipinos at the University of 11 Hawaii; and

WHEREAS, the Pamantasan Council has held the annual Pamantasan Conferences, organized activities, and developed recommendations to increase representation of students, faculty, staff, and curriculum of the Filipino community; and 17

18 WHEREAS, the Legislature adopted Act 266, Session Laws of 19 Hawaii 2019, to appropriate funds for two full-time equivalent 20 (2.0 FTE) positions for the University of Hawaii Pamantasan 21 Council to assist the State and the University of Hawaii in 22 meeting strategic goals for access, diversity, and workforce 23 development; and

24 25 WHEREAS, despite the Governor's approval of the 26 appropriation, the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting budget 27 restrictions prevented the hiring of two positions for the 28 Pamantasan Council; and

30 WHEREAS, funds approved for the Pamantasan Council are now 31 utilized to temporarily support a University of Hawaii Maui 32 College lecturer to teach distance education Ilokano courses and 33 for curriculum development of a community college-level 34 certificate in Filipino Studies and coordination with the 35 University of Hawaii at Manoa's Ethnic Studies Department for 36 course development; now, therefore, 37

38 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 39 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, 40 that the University of Hawaii is requested to report on the 41 Pamantasan Council's systemwide efforts to improve the status of 42 Filipinos at the University of Hawaii; and



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1 2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the report is requested to include information regarding the 2019 appropriation; resource 3 and budgetary needs; recommendations on curriculum development; 4 and representation and success of students, faculty, and staff; 5 and 6 7 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Hawaii is 9 requested to submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 10 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 11 the Regular Session of 2023; and 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this 14 Resolution be transmitted to the President of the University of 15 Hawaii. 16 17 18 OFFERED BY: Bennetter Minluch 19
