SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF PRIMARY CARE AND RURAL HEALTH TO INITIATE A 2030 ONE SHARED HEALTH VISION PLAN IN HAWAI'I COUNTY.

1 WHEREAS, improving public health is a complex issue that 2 requires an examination of the social determinants that may 3 impact whether a community has continuous access to health care 4 resources; and

6 WHEREAS, a coordinated effort at all levels of government, 7 as well as in collaboration with private medical providers, is 8 necessary to support this important examination; and 9

10 WHEREAS, Hawai'i County has faced disproportionate 11 challenges in delivering appropriate, quality health care 12 services to its residents compared to other counties in the 13 State because of the many socioeconomically-disadvantaged, 14 unserved and underserved rural areas throughout the island that 15 are geographically distant from population hubs such as Kailua-16 Kona and Hilo; and

WHEREAS, according to a 2021 nursing education study, Hawai'i County ranks third on the list of counties in the nation with the highest primary health care worker shortage, with fifty-three percent fewer doctors than comparable counties on the mainland due to the hundreds of Hawai'i County-based medical providers having recently retired, moved, or reduced their hours; and

26 WHEREAS, the establishment of a strong health network based 27 in Hawai'i County would greatly improve the county's ability to 28 coordinate care and can serve as a model of collaboration for 29 other areas throughout the State; and

31 WHEREAS, the success of such a health network would result 32 in Hawai'i County being able to efficiently develop a ten-year 33 health care plan, including preventative and primary health 34 care, specialty care, and urgent and emergency care; and

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1 WHEREAS, the Office of Primary Care and Rural Health, part 2 of the Department of Health's Family Health Services Division, 3 is tasked with coordinating federal, state, and local efforts 4 aimed at improving the health of the State's rural and medically 5 underserved populations; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the Office of Primary Care and Rural Health is 8 uniquely positioned to organize Hawai'i County's efforts to 9 streamline the delivery of quality health care; now, therefore, 10 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 12 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, 13 that the Office of Primary Care and Rural Health is requested to 14 initiate a 2030 One Shared Health Vision Plan and establish a 15 pilot program in Hawai'i County; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Primary Care and 18 Rural Health is requested to facilitate discussions with key 19 community health and social service organizations in Hawai'i 20 21 County to address the health and wellness needs of the most vulnerable by aligning the goals, objectives, and availability 22 of services of appropriate community health care service 23 providers; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Primary Care and 26 Rural Health is requested to submit a report on the 2030 One 27 Shared Health Vision Plan for Hawai'i County, including any 28 proposed long-term legislative grant-in-aid requests, to the 29 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 30 the Regular Session of 2023; and 31 32 33 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Health, Chief of 34 the Family Health Services Division, and Mayor of Hawai'i County. 35 36 37 38 OFFERED BY:
