SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE COUNTIES TO UTILIZE AN EMPTY HOMES TAX AS A MEANS OF ADDRESSING AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN THE STATE.

WHEREAS, property taxes in the State are among the lowest 1 2 in the nation at approximately .28 percent; and 3 4 WHEREAS, about one fourth of all housing in the State is owned by people who do not reside in the State; and 5 6 7 WHEREAS, low property taxes have benefitted real estate investors, many of whom do not reside in the State and purchase 8 homes and other residential properties as investments or second 9 10 homes; and 11 WHEREAS, a significant number of residential investment 12 properties are vacant, which, combined with low property taxes, 13 14 negatively impacts the housing supply statewide and results in less revenues for the counties and government services; and 15 16 17 WHEREAS, homes and other residential properties that are 18 vacant for extended periods of time negatively impact the 19 State's housing supply by taking housing units out of the 20 housing market and contributing to a scarcity of affordable 21 housing and a prevalence of homelessness in the State; and 22 23 WHEREAS, in 2017, the empty homes tax, also known as the 24 vacancy tax, was introduced in Vancouver, British Columbia to help return vacant and under-utilized properties to the market 25 as long-term rental homes for people who live and work in 26 Vancouver and support affordable housing initiatives; and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, under Vancouver's empty homes tax: 30 31 (1)Thirty-six percent of properties declared or deemed 32 vacant in 2019 were converted to occupied in 2020; 33

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(2) There was a twenty-six percent reduction in vacant 1 properties from 2017 to 2020; and 2 3 (3) \$86,600,000 of revenues from the empty homes tax were 4 5 allocated to support affordable housing initiatives between 2017 and 2020; and 6 7 WHEREAS, Vancouver's empty homes tax does not apply to 8 9 principal residences, homes that qualify for an exemption, or homes rented for at least six months of the year; and 10 11 WHEREAS, adopting a tax similar to Vancouver's empty homes 12 13 tax would help return vacant or under-utilized properties to the State's long-term rental housing inventory and relieve pressure 14 15 on the State's rental housing market; now, therefore, 16 17 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first 18 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, that the City and County of Honolulu and the counties of Hawaii, 19 Kauai, and Maui are urged to utilize an empty homes tax, similar 20 to the Vancouver, British Columbia empty homes tax, as a means 21 of addressing affordable housing in the State; and 22 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 24 25 Resolution be transmitted to the Mayor and Council Chair of the City and County of Honolulu and the Mayors and Council Chairs of 26 the counties of Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui. 27 28 29 OFFERED BY: 30

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
