SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE EARLY LEARNING BOARD TO EVALUATE AND REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE REGARDING THE BOARD'S COMPOSITION AND CHARTER AND TO DEVELOP A STRATEGIC PLAN.

WHEREAS, Act 202, Session Laws of Hawaii 2017, expanded the 1 purview of the Early Learning Board, elevated the Board from an 2 3 advisory to governing capacity, and altered the composition of the board; and 4 5 6 WHEREAS, the Early Learning Board's charter was originally adopted in 2014, when the Board acted solely in an advisory 7 capacity; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the Early Learning Board is placed within the 10 Department of Education for administrative purposes, is tasked 11 with the critical function of formulating statewide policy 12 relating to early learning, and is responsible for: 13 14 Directing the Executive Office on Early Learning 15 (1) (EOEL) on how best to meet the developmental and 16 educational needs of children, from prenatal care to 17 entry into kindergarten; 18 19 20 (2) Providing recommendations to EOEL on improving the quality, availability, and coordination of early 21 learning programs; 22 23 (3) Promoting collaboration across agencies and 24 stakeholders serving young children; and 25 26 Appointing the EOEL director and evaluating the 27 (4) director on an annual basis; and 28 29 WHEREAS, since 2017, multiple measures have been introduced 30 to amend or add to the composition of the Early Learning Board, 31 without comprehensive consideration of the Board's charter or 32 strategic plan; and 33



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1 WHEREAS, the composition of the Early Learning Board is set 2 by statute and is not subject to the discretion of the Board; 3 and 4 5 WHEREAS, the Early Learning Board's charter and any 6 strategic planning, on the other hand, are matters within the 7 purview of the Board's discretion; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, an evaluation of the current board composition and charter, in relation to the development of a strategic plan, is 11 necessary to inform any future legislation related to the 12 composition of the Early Learning Board or its powers and 13 14 functions; now, therefore, 15 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022, 17 18 that the Early Learning Board is requested to conduct an evaluation of its current composition and charter, in relation 19 20 to the development of a strategic plan; and 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Early Learning Board is requested to develop a five-year strategic plan, propose 23 amendments to its charter, or both, to guide the Early Learning 24 25 Board going forward and inform any improvements thereto; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Early Learning Board is requested to submit a report to the Legislature no later than 28 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 29 30 2023 that includes the following: 31 Findings and recommendations, including any proposed 32 (1) legislation, related to the Board's composition; 33 34 35 (2) Findings and recommendations, including any proposed amendments, related to the Board's charter; and 36 37 (3) Findings and recommendations related to the 38 39 development and implementation of a five-year strategic plan for the Board, if any; and 40 41
