
SENATE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO ENDORSE THE NEW PLASTICS ECONOMY
GLOBAL COMMITMENT AND THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND
SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT TO SET TARGETS TO FULFILL THE NEW
PLASTICS ECONOMY GLOBAL COMMITMENT.

1 WHEREAS, the wasteful use of plastics continues to threaten
2 the State's health and environment; and

3
4 WHEREAS, one million plastic bottles are purchased every
5 minute and over five trillion plastic bags are used annually;
6 and

8 WHEREAS, many plastic products are designed for single-use
9 and sixty percent of all plastic products produced since 1950
10 have eventually ended up in landfills or natural environments;
11 and

13 WHEREAS, Hawaii is particularly vulnerable to the effects
14 of plastic pollution, which pose a threat to the State's unique
15 natural environments and vital tourism sector; and

17 WHEREAS, in January 2020, the Guardian named Kamilo Beach
18 on Hawaii island as one of the most plastic-polluted places on
19 the globe and, in July of the same year, the Environmental
20 Protection Agency deemed the beach to be contaminated by the
21 high volumes of plastic waste; and

23 WHEREAS, the Ellen MacArthur Foundation and the United
24 Nations Environment Programme have created a New Plastics
25 Economy Global Commitment to set goals and standards for the use
26 of plastic products; and

28 WHEREAS, the New Plastics Economy Global Commitment aims to
29 reduce reliance on single-use plastic products and limit the
30 production of plastic waste by:

- 1 (1) Eliminating unnecessary plastic packaging and

- 4 (2) Encouraging reuse;

- 6 (3) Incentivizing reusable, recyclable, and compostable
- 7 packaging;

- 9 (4) Increasing collection and sorting of waste;

- 11 (5) Stimulating demand for recycled plastics; and

- 13 (6) Supporting social and behavioral change; and

15 WHEREAS, the State is already a signatory of the United
 16 Nations Sustainable Development Goals; and

 18 WHEREAS, the next step toward greater sustainability
 19 includes endorsement of the Global Commitment for a New Plastics
 20 Economy; now, therefore,

 22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Thirty-first
 23 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2022,
 24 that the Governor is requested to endorse the Ellen MacArthur
 25 Foundation and United Nations Environment Programme's New
 26 Plastics Economy Global Commitment; and

 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Planning and
 29 Sustainable Development is requested to develop and publish
 30 meaningful targets to achieve the goals of the New Plastics
 31 Economy Global Commitment and to implement policies in pursuit
 32 of those targets; and

 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
 35 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and Director of the
 36 Office of Planning and Sustainable Development.
