A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC AGENCY MEETINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 92-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§92-4 Executive meetings. (a) A board may hold an executive meeting that is closed to the public upon an 4 5 affirmative vote, taken at an open meeting, of two-thirds of the members present; provided the affirmative vote constitutes a 6 7 majority of the members to which the board is entitled. A 8 meeting closed to the public shall be limited to matters exempted by section 92-5. The reason for holding such a meeting 9 10 shall be publicly announced and the vote of each member on the 11 question of holding a meeting that is closed to the public shall 12 be recorded $[\tau]$ and entered into the minutes of the meeting.

(b) Any discussion or final action taken by a board in an
executive meeting shall be reported to the public when the board
reconvenes in the open meeting at which the executive meeting is
held; provided that in describing the discussion or final action
taken by the board:

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1 (1) The information reported shall not be inconsistent 2 with the purpose for which the executive meeting was convened pursuant to section 92-5, including matters 3 4 affecting the privacy of individuals; and 5 (2) The board may maintain confidentiality for the 6 information described in paragraph (1) for as long as 7 disclosure would defeat the purpose of convening the 8 executive meeting." SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023. 11 12
