5		otherwise acquire all books and other publications
6		proper for libraries, and arrange, classify, manage,
7		and catalog the same;
8	(2)	[ <del>provide</del> ] <u>Provide</u> for [ <del>their</del> ] safekeeping[ <del>;</del> ] <u>of the</u>
9		<pre>foregoing;</pre>
10	(3)	[expend] Expend moneys appropriated by the legislature
11		and otherwise acquired for the development, use,
12		support, and maintenance of libraries and other
13		related purposes;
14	(4)	[provide] Provide ways and means for placing libraries
15		within reach of all residents throughout the State and
16		particularly of all public and private school
