## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 286-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y amending subsection (g) to read as follows:
3	"(g)	The provisions of this part requiring the
4	registrat	ion of motor vehicles shall not apply to:
5	(1)	Special mobile equipment;
6	(2)	Implements of husbandry temporarily drawn, moved, or
7		otherwise propelled upon the public highways;
8	(3)	Aircraft servicing vehicles that are being used
9		exclusively on lands set aside to the department of
10		transportation for airport purposes; and
11	(4)	Tractor trucks, flatbed trucks, forklifts, and top
12		picks being used as marine terminal equipment
13		temporarily moving in or between terminals at:
14		(A) Sand Island and along Sand Island Parkway and
15		Sand Island Access Road;
16		(B) Kalanianaole Avenue between Kuhio Street and
17		Kahanu Street, abutting Hilo Harbor;

1 Kawaihae-Mahukona Road abutting Kawaihae Harbor; (C) 2 (D) East Kaahumanu Avenue between Hobron Avenue and 3 Kane Street, abutting Kahului Harbor; [and] 4 (E) [Waipaa] Waapa Road abutting Nawiliwili 5 Harbor[+]; 6 (F) Nimitz Highway, between 8:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., 7 and between 6:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.; 8 Sand Island Access Road and Forrest Avenue, (G) 9 including all roadways abutting pier accessways; 10 provided that vehicles abide by the speed limit 11 and keep up with the flow of traffic; 12 Auiki Street, abutting Kapalama Container (H) 13 Terminal; 14 (I) Malakole Street, abutting Barbers Point; and 15 Hanua Street, abutting Barbers Point; provided (J) 16 that an escort vehicle is present." 17 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 19 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
