# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXPUNGEMENT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that court records for an 2 arrest or case that has been expunded from a person's record may 3 still be accessed by prospective employers, landlords, lenders, educational institutions, and others. Though expunged, these 4 5 records can be regarded negatively and have a significant and 6 long-lasting impact on a person's future. The legislature 7 further finds that for a person who has received an expungement 8 order, the current process to have their records and other 9 information pertaining to the arrest or case sealed or removed 10 from the judiciary's publicly accessible electronic database 11 requires yet another petition.

12 The purpose of this Act is to require the court to 13 automatically seal or remove from the judiciary's publicly 14 accessible databases any information relevant to the arrest or 15 case of a person for whom an expungement order has been entered 16 and transmitted to the court.
