# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE COUNCIL.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 107-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

"(a) There is established a state building code council. 3 4 The council shall be placed within the department of accounting 5 and general services for administrative purposes only. The 6 council shall consist of [eleven] twelve voting members and one 7 nonvoting member, who shall be the comptroller or the comptroller's designee. The council members shall serve 8 9 four-year terms. The voting members shall include: 10 (1)One county building official from each of the four counties appointed by the mayor; 11 12 (2)One member representing the state fire council; 13 (3)One member representing the department of labor and 14 industrial relations, who has significant experience

15 in elevator safety;

**3** SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
