A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 279L, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is,
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§279L- Parking; regulation. (a) The department of
5 transportation may regulate parking utilized by peer-to-peer car
6 sharing at state airports.

7 (b) The counties may, by ordinance, regulate parking
8 utilized by shared cars."

9 SECTION 2. Section 431:10C-802, Hawaii Revised Statutes,
10 is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

11 "(a) A peer-to-peer car-sharing program shall ensure
12 that during each car-sharing period, the shared car [~~shall~~
13 ~~be~~] is insured under a motor vehicle insurance policy that
14 [~~shall provide:~~] provides:

15 (1) Primary insurance coverage for each shared car
16 available and used through a peer-to-peer car-
17 sharing program in amounts [~~not~~] no less than
18 [\$750,000] four times the amounts set forth in



1 section 431:10C-301(b) for death, bodily injury, and
2 property damage per accident, and costs of defense
3 outside the limits;

4 (2) Primary insurance coverage for each shared car
5 available and used through a peer-to-peer car-
6 sharing program for personal injury protection
7 coverage that meets the minimum coverage amounts
8 required by section 431:10C-103.5; and

9 (3) The following optional coverages, which any named
10 insured may elect to reject or purchase, that
11 provides primary coverage for each shared car
12 available and used through a peer-to-peer car-
13 sharing program:

14 (A) Uninsured and underinsured motorist coverages
15 as provided in section 431:10C-301, which shall
16 be equal to the primary liability limits
17 specified in this section; provided that
18 uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage
19 offers shall provide for written rejection of
20 the coverages as provided in section 431:10C-
21 301;



- 1 (B) Uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage
2 stacking options as provided in section
3 431:10C-301; provided that the offer of the
4 stacking options shall provide for written
5 rejection as provided in section 431:10C-301;
- 6 (C) An offer of required optional additional
7 insurance coverages as provided in section
8 431:10C-302; and
- 9 (D) In the event the only named insured under the
10 motor vehicle insurance policy issued pursuant
11 to this section is the peer-to-peer car-sharing
12 program, the insurer or the peer-to-peer car-
13 sharing program shall:
- 14 (i) Disclose the coverages in writing to the
15 [~~peer to peer car sharing~~] shared car
16 driver;
- 17 (ii) Disclose to the [~~peer to peer car sharing~~]
18 shared car driver in writing that all
19 optional coverages available may not have
20 been purchased under sections 431:10C-301
21 and 431:10C-302; and



1 (iii) Obtain a written acknowledgement from the
2 [~~peer to peer car sharing~~] shared car
3 driver of receipt of the written
4 disclosures required in paragraphs (1) and
5 (2). The standard disclosure forms used
6 in paragraphs (1) and (2), and every
7 modification of [~~such~~] forms intended to
8 be used, shall be filed with the
9 commissioner within fifteen days of
10 providing [~~such~~] the disclosure to the
11 [~~peer to peer car sharing~~] shared car
12 driver. The insurer or the peer-to-peer
13 car-sharing program shall also send to the
14 [~~peer to peer car sharing~~] shared car
15 driver every modified disclosure form
16 within fifteen days of the filing of
17 [~~such~~] the modified disclosure form and
18 comply with paragraph (3). [~~Such~~] The
19 disclosures and acknowledgement may be
20 sent and received by electronic means."



1 SECTION 3. Act 56, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, is amended
2 by amending section 5 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1,
4 2023 [~~and shall be repealed on June 30, 2025~~]."

5 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2024.


