A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COLLECTIVE BARGAINING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 89-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:			
3	"(b) The board shall be composed of three members of which			
4	[-(1)] one member shall be representative of management, $[-(2)]$			
5	one member shall be representative of labor, and $[\frac{3}{3}]$ the third			
6	member, the chairperson, shall be representative of the public.			
7	All members shall be appointed for terms of six years each in			
8	accordance with the following procedures:			
9	(1) The representative of management shall be appointed by			
10	the governor, who may first consider any names			
11	submitted by the counties; provided that each county			
12	may submit no more than one name;			
13	(2) The representative of labor shall be a person who is			
14	appointed by the governor [from a list of three			
15	nominces submitted by mutual agreement from a majority			
16	of the exclusive representatives;] and whose name has			
17	been submitted to the governor to serve as the			



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1		representative of labor by the exclusive
2		representatives certified pursuant to section 89-8.
3		The process to determine the nominee whose name is to
4		be submitted to the governor shall be determined by a
5		simple majority of the exclusive representatives
6		certified pursuant to section 89-8. The governor
7		shall transmit the name of the person nominated to
8		serve as the representative of labor to the senate for
9		advice and consent; and
10	(3)	The representative of the public shall be appointed by
11		the governor."
12	SECT	ION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
13	and stric	ken. New statutory material is underscored.
14	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
