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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DECLARATION OF WATER SHORTAGE AND EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 174C-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

"[+]\$174C-62[+] Declaration of water shortage[-] and
emergency. (a) The commission shall formulate a statewide plan
for implementation during periods of water shortage. As a part
of the plan, the commission shall adopt a reasonable system of
permit classification according to source of water supply,
method of extraction or diversion, use of water, or a
combination thereof.

(b) The commission, by rule, may declare that a water
shortage exists within all or part of an area, whether within or
<u>outside of a water management area</u>, when insufficient water is
available to meet the requirements of the permit system or when
conditions are such as to require a temporary reduction in total
water use within the area to protect water resources from
serious harm. The commission shall publish a set of criteria

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for determining when a water shortage exists [-,], including but 1 2 not limited to impacts and effects of the climate crisis. 3 In accordance with the plan adopted under subsection (C) 4 (a), the commission may impose such restrictions on one or more 5 classes of permits and outside of management areas on well and 6 stream diversion owners and operators as may be necessary to 7 protect the water resources of the area from serious harm and to 8 restore them to their previous water quantity or chloride level 9 condition. 10 (d) A declaration of water shortage and any measures 11 adopted pursuant thereto may be rescinded by rule by the 12 commission. 13 When a water shortage is declared, the commission (e) 14 shall cause a notice [thereof] of the water shortage to be 15 published in a prominent place in a newspaper of general 16 circulation throughout the area[-,] and the commission's website. 17 The notice shall be published each day for the first week of the 18 shortage and once a week [thereafter] for four months, followed 19 by monthly publications until the declaration is rescinded. 20 Publication of [such] the notice shall serve as notice to all 21 water users in the area of the condition of water shortage.

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(f) The commission shall cause each permittee in the area
 to be notified by regular <u>and electronic</u> mail of any change in
 the conditions of the permittee's permit, any suspension
 [thereof_r] <u>of the permittee's permit</u>, or of any other
 restriction on the use of water for the duration of the water
 shortage.

7 (q) If an emergency condition arises [due to a water 8 shortage within any area], whether within or outside of a water 9 management area, [and if the commission finds that the 10 restrictions imposed under subsection (c) are not sufficient to 11 protect the public health, safety, or welfare, or the health of 12 animals, fish, or aquatic life, or a public water supply, or 13 recreational, municipal, agricultural, or other reasonable 14 $\frac{uses_{r}}{1}$] the commission may issue orders reciting the existence of 15 [such] the emergency and requiring that such actions as the 16 commission deems necessary to meet the emergency be taken, 17 including but not limited to apportioning, rotating, limiting, 18 or prohibiting the use of the water resources of the area. Any 19 party to whom an emergency order is directed may challenge such 20 an order but shall immediately comply with the order, pending 21 disposition of the party's challenge. The commission shall give

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1 precedence to a hearing on such challenge over all other pending 2 matters. 3 (h) When a water shortage or emergency results in a long 4 term or permanent reduction of the available water source, the 5 commission may, after a hearing, modify, suspend, or revoke 6 water use permits relying on that water source." 7 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
