
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
FIFTEENTH AND SEVENTEENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$14,811,090 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 fifteenth and seventeenth representative districts, as follows:

7 1. Cook field, Waimea, Kaua'i

8 Plans and construction for the repair
9 and remediation of retaining walls,
10 replacement of fencing, and tennis
11 court rehabilitation.

12 Plans \$260,000

13 Construction \$2,990,000

14 Total funding \$3,250,000

15 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
16 shall be expended by the county of Kauai.



1 2. Hanapepe Chinese, Filipino, and
 2 Portuguese cemetery, Hanapepe, Kaua'i
 3 Construction for a monument and other
 4 miscellaneous improvements.

5 Construction \$125,000

6 Total funding \$125,000

7 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 8 shall be expended by the department of accounting and general
 9 services.

10 3. Kāpa'a elementary school, Kaua'i
 11 Construction for a campus covered
 12 walkway and campus-wide electrical
 13 upgrade.

14 Construction \$7,276,090

15 Total funding \$7,276,090

16 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 17 shall be expended by the department of accounting and general
 18 services.

19 4. Kāpa'a high school, Kaua'i
 20 Design for new Kāpa'a high school gym.

21 Design \$2,060,000



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1 Cane Haul road, Hauaala road, and
 2 Kawaihau road.
 3 Plans \$300,000
 4 Total funding \$300,000

5 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project
 6 shall be expended by the department of transportation and Hawaii
 7 health systems corporation.

8 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
 9 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 10 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;
 11 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as
 12 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
