A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that article VII, 2 section 6, of the Hawaii State Constitution requires the legislature to dispose of excess general fund revenues when 3 4 certain factors are met, as follows: 5 "(1) Provide for a tax refund or tax credit to the 6 taxpayers of the State, as provided by law; 7 (2) Make a deposit into one or more funds, as provided by 8 law, which shall serve as temporary supplemental 9 sources of funding for the State in times of an 10 emergency, economic downturn, or unforeseen reduction 11 in revenue, as provided by law; or 12 (3) Appropriate general funds for the pre-payment of 13 either or both of the following, as provided by law: 14 (A) Debt service for general obligation bonds issued 15 by the State; or 16 (B) Pension or other post-employment benefit 17 liabilities accrued for state employees."

1	The legislature further finds that the necessary factors
2	have been met for two successive fiscal years and that the
3	legislature is constitutionally required to dispose of excess
4	tax revenues, as authorized under article VII, section 6, of the

7	article VII, section 6, of the Hawaii State Constitution, by
8	providing for an income tax refund to every resident individual
