A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. The purpose of this Act is to:
2	(1)	Amend Act 125, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, to extend
3		the time to expend appropriations for the
4		establishment of a pilot visitation and family
5		resource center at Waiawa correctional facility on
6		Oahu, and make conforming amendments related to the
7		establishment of the department of corrections and
8		rehabilitation; and
9	(2)	Appropriate additional funds to implement the pilot
10		visitation and family resource center at Waiawa
11		correctional facility on Oahu.
12	SECT	ION 2. Act 125, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022, is
13	amended b	y amending sections 3 and 4 to read as follows:
14	"SEC	TION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
15	revenues	of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$305,000 or so much
16	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the

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1	establishment of a pilot visitation and family resource center		
2	at Waiawa correctional facility on Oahu.		
3	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
4	human services for the purposes of this Act.		
5	The appropriation made by this section for fiscal year		
6	2022-2023 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for		
7	which the appropriation is made; provided that any unexpended		
8	and unencumbered balance of the appropriation as of the close of		
9	business on June 30, 2024, shall lapse on that date.		
10	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general		
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$115,000 or so much		
12	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the		
13	establishment of a pilot visitation and family resource center		
14	at Waiawa correctional facility on Oahu.		
15	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of		
16	public safety or its successor department of corrections and		
17	rehabilitation for the purposes of this Act.		
18	The appropriation made by this section for fiscal year		
19	2022-2023 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal year for		
20	which the appropriation is made; provided that any unexpended		
21	and unencumbered balance of the appropriation as of the close of		



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1	business on December 31, 2023, shall be transferred to the			
2	department of corrections and rehabilitation pursuant to section			
3	48 of Act 278, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022; provided further			
4	that any unexpended and unencumbered balance of the			
5	appropriation as of the close of business on June 30, 2024,			
6	shall lapse on that date."			
7	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general			
8	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so			
9	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and			
10	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal			
11	year 2024-2025 to operate the pilot visitation and family			
12	resource center at Waiawa correctional facility on Oahu.			
13	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department			
14	of human services for the purposes of this Act.			
15	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general			
16	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so			
17	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 for			
18	additional improvements required by the pilot visitation and			
19	family resource center at Waiawa correctional facility on Oahu.			
20	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of			
21	public safety for the purposes of this Act; provided that any			

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unexpended and unencumbered balance of the appropriation as of
 the close of business on December 31, 2023, shall be transferred
 to the department of corrections and rehabilitation pursuant to
 section 48 of Act 278, Session Laws of Hawaii 2022.

SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general
revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2024-2025 for
additional improvements required by the pilot visitation and
family resource center at Waiawa correctional facility on Oahu.
The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
corrections and rehabilitation for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 6. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023;
14 provided that section 2 of this Act shall take effect on
15 June 29, 2023.
