# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 286-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:  
3           "(g) The provisions of this part requiring the  
4 registration of motor vehicles shall not apply to:  
5           (1) Special mobile equipment;  
6           (2) Implements of husbandry temporarily drawn, moved, or  
7           otherwise propelled upon the public highways;  
8           (3) Aircraft servicing vehicles that are being used  
9           exclusively on lands set aside to the department of  
10           transportation for airport purposes; and  
11           (4) Tractor trucks, flatbed trucks, forklifts, and top  
12           picks being used as marine terminal equipment  
13           temporarily moving in or between terminals at:  
14           (A) Sand Island and along Sand Island Parkway and  
15           Sand Island Access Road;  
16           (B) Kalaniana'ole Avenue between Kuhio Street and  
17           Kahanu Street, abutting Hilo Harbor;



- 1 (C) Kawaihae-Mahukona Road abutting Kawaihae Harbor;
- 2 (D) East Kaahumanu Avenue between Hobron Avenue and
- 3 Kane Street, abutting Kahului Harbor; [~~and~~]
- 4 (E) Waipaa Road abutting Nawiliwili Harbor[-];
- 5 (F) Nimitz Highway, between 8:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.,
- 6 and from 6:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.;
- 7 (G) Sand Island Access Road and Forrest Avenue,
- 8 including all roadways abutting pier accessways;
- 9 provided that vehicles abide by the speed limit
- 10 and keep up with the flow of traffic;
- 11 (H) Auiki Street, abutting Kapalama Container
- 12 Terminal;
- 13 (I) Malakole Street, abutting Barbers Point; and
- 14 (J) Hanua Street, abutting Barbers Point; provided
- 15 that an escort vehicle is present."

16 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.



**Report Title:**

Motor Vehicle Registration; Flatbed Trucks; Exemption

**Description:**

Provides an exemption for flatbed trucks from registration renewals and initial registrations of motor carrier vehicles when used as marine terminal equipment temporarily moving in or between certain terminals. Adds new terminal locales and roadways to be covered under the exemption. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)
