## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
TWENTY-SEVENTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$29,154,900 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024  
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the twenty-  
6 seventh representative district, as follows:

7     1.   Ma'ema'e elementary school

8           Plans, design, construction, and  
9           equipment and appurtenances for school-  
10          wide telecom upgrades.

13	Construction	\$400,000	
14	Equipment	\$2,400,000	
15	Total funding		\$3,000,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 2. Nu‘uanu elementary school

5 the covered gym with fencing and other  
6 improvements.

7 Design \$250,000

8 Construction \$1,500,000

9 Total funding \$1,750,000

10 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
11 shall be expended by the department of education.

12 3. Nu‘uanu elementary school

13 Design and construction for resurfacing  
14 the visitor and staff parking lots  
15 along with driveways and other  
16 improvements.

17 Design \$200,000

18 Construction \$1,000,000

19 Total funding \$1,200,000

20 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
21 shall be expended by the department of education.



1 4. Nu‘uanu elementary school  
2 Design and construction to resurface  
3 the covered gym floor and other gym  
4 improvements.  
5 Design \$100,000  
6 Construction \$350,000  
7 Total funding \$450,000  
8 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
9 shall be expended by the department of education.

10 5. Nu‘uanu elementary school  
11 Plans, land, design, construction, and  
12 equipment and appurtenances for  
13 constructing an eight classroom  
14 building on top of the library and  
15 other library improvements.  
16 Plans \$4,200,000  
17 Land \$4,200,000  
18 Design \$4,200,000  
19 Construction \$4,200,000  
20 Equipment \$4,200,000  
21 Total funding \$21,000,000



1 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
2 shall be expended by the department of education.

3 6. Nu‘uanu elementary school

4 Plans, land, design, construction, and  
5 equipment and appurtenances for  
6 renovating the school kitchen and  
7 cafeteria facilities.

13 Total funding \$1,600,000

14 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project  
15 shall be expended by the department of education.

16 7. Pauoa elementary school

17 Design for providing a cover for the  
18 play court or to build a multi-purpose  
19 building for students play in when the  
20 play courts are wet and unsafe.


6 The sum appropriated for this capital improvement project

10 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriation is made;  
11 provided that all moneys from the appropriation unencumbered as  
12 of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
