HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT AN ANALYSIS REGARDING THE SCOPE OF PRACTICE FOR ADVANCED PRACTICE REGISTERED NURSES AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS.

WHEREAS, this body recognizes that there is a physician 1 shortage in the State, which often makes it challenging for 2 rural communities to access health care; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants are vital health care professionals who are capable 6 of filling in some of the gaps in access to health care in the 7 State; and 8 9 WHEREAS, various measures have been introduced during the 10 past regular sessions of the Legislature that have proposed 11 12 expanding the scope of practice for advanced practice registered nurses and physician assistants; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, there is a need to clearly distinguish the scope of practice of advanced practice registered nurses and physician 16 assistants and determine the appropriate scope of practice for 17 each of these professions in the State to better complement the 18 work of physicians; now, therefore, 19 20 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 21 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 22 23 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is requested to conduct an analysis regarding the scope of practice 24 for advanced practice registered nurses and physician 25 assistants; and 26 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 29 analyze whether each scope of practice should be expanded in 30 certain areas of medical care and services, including:

9 10	(4)	The records review process for prescriptions of controlled substances;

17 18 19 20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor may include in the Auditor's analysis a comparison to other jurisdictions and whether those jurisdictions allow for similar expanded scopes of practice; and
