HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE HAWAII INVASIVE SPECIES COUNCIL, IN COORDINATION AND COLLABORATION WITH THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU AND COUNTY OF HAWAII, TO ESTABLISH AND IMPLEMENT A FIVE-YEAR PILOT PROGRAM TO MITIGATE AND CONTROL THE SIGNIFICANT INCREASE IN THE POPULATION OF FERAL CHICKENS.

WHEREAS, feral chickens have become a persistent nuisance, 1 2 particularly in suburban and urban residential communities; and 3 4 WHEREAS, feral chickens wander into yards and gardens, digging up plants, damaging food crops, and jeopardizing native 5 plants and resources; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, feral roosters crow at all times of the day and night, which has led to numerous noise complaints by residents 9 throughout the State; and 10 11 WHEREAS, droppings from feral chickens are unsanitary and 12 create a health hazard; and 13 14 WHEREAS, feral chickens and birds also carry diseases that 15 threaten other animals, including native birds; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the noticeable increase in the number of feral 18 chickens and birds also creates a road hazard for drivers who 19 must suddenly stop or swerve to avoid them; and 20 21 WHEREAS, to protect Hawaii's ecosystem, natural resources, 22 and the health and safety of its residents, it is critical that 23 the State work together with the counties and the affected 24 communities, including hunters, farmers, and natural resource 25 managers, to identify and implement collaborative solutions to 26 control the significant increase in the population of feral 27 chickens and pigs; now, therefore, 28

1 2 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 3 4 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Hawaii Invasive Species Council, in coordination and collaboration with the City 5 and County of Honolulu and County of Hawaii, is requested to 6 establish and implement a five-year pilot program to mitigate 7 and control the significant increase in the population of feral 8 chickens; and 9 10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the five-year pilot program is 11 requested to include the provision of free traps to members of 12 the public to capture the feral animals, collection of traps 13 containing the captured feral animals, and return of empty traps 14 to the members of the public; and 15 16 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the five-year pilot program is 17 requested to begin in the areas of Moanalua, Kalihi, Kalaeloa, 18 and Kapolei in the City and County of Honolulu and the Puna area 19 in the County of Hawaii; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Hawaii Invasive Species 22 Council is requested to submit an interim report regarding the 23 five-year pilot program to the Legislature no later than twenty 24 days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2026, and 25 a final report to the Legislature no later than twenty days 26 prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2028; provided 27 that the reports are requested to include: 28 29 (1)Findings and recommendations relating to the five-year 30 31 pilot program's efficacy in mitigating and controlling the significant increase in the population of feral 32 33 chickens, including any proposed legislation; and 34 A recommendation on whether the five-year pilot 35 (2) program should be extended or expanded into other 36 areas of the State; and 37 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 39 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Co-Chairpersons of 40 the Hawaii Invasive Species Council, Mayor of the City and 41 County of Honolulu, and Mayor of the County of Hawaii. 42
