HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING OCTOBER 2 THROUGH OCTOBER 6, 2023, AS DIGITAL INCLUSION WEEK IN THE STATE OF HAWAII.

WHEREAS, broadband services are essential infrastructure 1 for the twenty-first century and play an important role in 2 3 providing access to knowledge and opportunities from around the world; and 4 5 WHEREAS, digital equity ensures that all individuals and 6 communities have the information technology capacity needed for 7 8 full participation in society, democracy, and the economy and is 9 necessary for civic and cultural participation, lifelong 10 learning, and access to essential services, such as telemedicine, distance learning, and the workplace; and 11 12 WHEREAS, the coronavirus disease 2019 pandemic heightened 13 14 the demand for reliable, affordable internet connectivity as 15 work, education, and access to essential services have shifted online; and 16

18 WHEREAS, broadband access, where available, has helped to 19 deliver public health information to vulnerable Hawaii residents 20 who experience socioeconomic disparities and those who live in 21 underserved and unserved communities; and

WHEREAS, many rural, agricultural, and lower-income communities throughout the State lack access to reliable and affordable broadband due to the lack of infrastructure; discrimination in investment in delivering technology and technology-related services to specific areas or populations; or barriers derived from socioeconomic status, education, literacy, language, or disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the State is committed to promoting digital 1 inclusion to ensure that all individuals and communities, 2 including the most remote and disadvantaged, have access to 3 information and communication technologies, including 4 affordable, robust broadband internet service; internet-enabled 5 devices that meet the needs of the user; access to digital 6 literacy training; quality technical support; and applications 7 8 and online content designed to enable and encourage self-9 sufficiency, participation, and collaboration; and 10 11 WHEREAS, to raise awareness of the need for digital equity 12 and to promote digital inclusion, Senate Concurrent Resolution 13 No. 25, S.D. 1, Regular Session of 2022, recognized October 3 through October 7, 2022, as Digital Inclusion Week in the State; 14 15 and 16 WHEREAS, Digital Inclusion Week is spearheaded by the 17 National Digital Inclusion Alliance, which represents affiliated 18 19 organizations working toward digital equity by crafting, identifying, and disseminating financial and operational 20 21 resources for digital inclusion programs to raise awareness of solutions addressing home internet access, personal devices, and 22 23 local technology training and support programs; now, therefore, 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 25 26 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that October 2 through 27 October 6, 2023, is recognized as Digital Inclusion Week in the 28 29 State to raise awareness of the need for digital equity and to 30 promote digital inclusion; and 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 32 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor; Director 33 of Business, Economic Development, and Tourism; Strategic 34 Broadband Coordinator of the Hawaii Broadband and Digital Equity 35 36 Office; Mayor of the City and County of Honolulu; Mayor of the County of Maui; Mayor of the County of Kauai; and Mayor of the 37 County of Hawaii. 38
