HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS TO CONDUCT A STUDY THAT EVALUATES POSSIBLE METHODS OF FLOOD REMEDIATION AND FLOOD AVERSION FOR CERTAIN AREAS OF THE ISLAND OF MOLOKAI.

1 WHEREAS, flooding on the island of Molokai has become 2 increasingly dangerous, especially after two recent large storms; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, a number of beneficiaries of the Hawaiian Homes 6 Commission Act, 1920, as amended, reside on Molokai; and 7 8 WHEREAS, flooding has significantly affected the lives of 9 these beneficiaries, as their homes have been repeatedly 10 impacted by runoff and mud; and 11 12 WHEREAS, if the State fails to act, the problem will persist and become worse over time; now, therefore, 13 14 15 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 16 17 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 18 Hawaiian Home Lands is requested to conduct a study that 19 evaluates possible methods of flood remediation and flood 20 aversion for areas on the island of Molokai populated by 21 beneficiaries of the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 1920, as amended; and 22 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Hawaiian Home Lands may consult with appropriate governmental agencies, 25 26 experts, or other relevant persons in conducting the requested 27 study; and 28
