HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COMMUNITY COLLEGES TO ESTABLISH BACCALAUREATE DEGREE PROGRAMS IN AGRICULTURAL TECHNOLOGY, FOOD SCIENCE, AND EDUCATION AT LEEWARD COMMUNITY COLLEGE.

WHEREAS, there is a need for more baccalaureate degree 1 programs at the University of Hawaii Community Colleges; and 2 3 WHEREAS, there is also a need for agricultural technology 4 and food technology programs in leeward and central Oahu; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the majority of the State's farmers are nearing 7 the age of retirement, and without new farmers, food production 8 in the State will decline; and 9 10 WHEREAS, to increase the number of new farmers in the 11 State, the State needs agricultural technology and food 12 technology programs that introduce new technologies and products 13 into the agricultural industry; and 14 15 WHEREAS, new technologies will capture the attention of 16 students who have expressed interest in farming through their 17 participation in FFA, formerly known as Future Farmers of 18 America, in the State's public schools; and 19 20 WHEREAS, there is also a need for teaching programs in 21 22 leeward and central Oahu; and 23 WHEREAS, more teachers who are willing to work in rural 24 areas are needed in schools located in leeward and central Oahu 25 and on the North Shore of Oahu, with the highest need being 26 along the leeward coast; and 27 28 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii Leeward Community College 29 is accredited to offer two baccalaureate degree programs; and 30 31

WHEREAS, new programs at Leeward Community College can 1 become extensions for interested students enrolled in other 2 University of Hawaii Community Colleges who are unable to attend 3 Leeward Community College; now, therefore, 4

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 6 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 7 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the University of 8 Hawaii Community Colleges are urged to establish baccalaureate 9 degree programs in agricultural technology, food science, and 10 education at Leeward Community College; and 11

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 13 14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the President of the University of Hawaii System, University of Hawaii Vice President 15 for Community Colleges, and University of Hawaii Leeward 16 Community College Chancellor. 17
