## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE STATE PROCUREMENT OFFICE TO CLARIFY THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING WRITTEN PROTESTS THAT ARE BASED ON THE CONTENT OF A SOLICITATION.

1 WHEREAS, part VII of the Hawaii Public Procurement Code, codified as chapter 103D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, provides for 2 3 legal and contractual remedies related to the procurement process; and 4 5 WHEREAS, despite codification and ongoing revisions to the 6 existing law, there is still a lack of clarity and ongoing 7 8 confusion as to when a party is aggrieved during the procurement 9 process; and 10 WHEREAS, certain agencies are denying protests on the basis 11 that bidders are not considered aggrieved because an award has 12 not yet been made; and 13 14 WHEREAS, these agencies are also denying protests because 15 16 the bidder did not protest five days after the bid opening, when 17 the bidder knew or should have known that the bidder was 18 aggrieved; and 19 20 WHEREAS, procurement protest reviews can be lengthy, causing project delays and increasing project costs, which are 21 22 ultimately borne by the State's taxpayers; and 23 24 WHEREAS, it is imperative that deadlines for parties to 25 submit protests be clearly delineated; now, therefore, 26 27 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 28 29 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the State 30 Procurement Office is requested to clarify the deadline for



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1 submitting written protests that are based on the content of a 2 solicitation; and 3 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the State Procurement Office is requested to clearly define when parties must submit protests 5 under section 103D-701, Hawaii Revised Statutes, based on: 6 7 The content of the solicitation; 8 (1) 9 (2) An award or eventual award; and 10 11 All other protests; and 12 (3) 13 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Governor and Acting 15 Administrator of the State Procurement Office. 16 17 18 19
