HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF LAND AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO ADOPT ADMINISTRATIVE RULES PROHIBITING RECREATIONAL BOATING ACTIVITIES IN MARINE LIFE CONSERVATION DISTRICTS.

WHEREAS, a grounded vessel off of Honolua Bay, Maui, has 1 caused a fuel spill, leaking diesel into the water at one of 2 Maui's most well-known marine sanctuaries; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the vessel was initially anchored within three-5 hundred yards of Honolua Bay, which is an area designated as the 6 Honolua-Mokuleia Bay Marine Life Conservation District; and 7 8 WHEREAS, Marine Life Conservation Districts (MLCDs) are 9 established to protect delicate ocean ecosystems pursuant to 10 chapter 190, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the Department of Land 11 and Natural Resources regulates certain activities in these 12 areas, such as requiring permits for the taking of marine life 13 for scientific, education, or other public purposes; and 14 15 WHEREAS, while the Department, subject to chapter 91, 16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, may adopt rules for the regulation of 17 anchoring, mooring, and recreational boating in each MLCD, there 18 are currently no administrative rules specifically prohibiting 19 recreational boating use in MLCDs, although certain rules exist 20 relating to the anchoring and mooring of a vessel at Molokini 21 Shoal MLCD, Old Kona Airport MLCD, and Waiopae Tidepools MLCD; 22 23 and 24 WHEREAS, due to the highly fragile nature of the ocean 25 ecosystems found in these conservation areas, ideally, only 26 activities regulated by permit should be allowed within MLCDs; 27 now, therefore, 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 30 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular 31 Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, the Department of Land 32

and Natural Resources is requested to adopt administrative rules
prohibiting recreational boating activities in Marine Life
Conservation Districts; and

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 6 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairperson of the 7 Board of Land and Natural Resources, Administrator of the 8 Division of Aquatic Resources, and Administrator of the Division 9 of Boating and Ocean Recreation.
