

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, IN COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICES OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU, TO INSTALL SPEED BUMPS AND OTHER TRAFFIC CALMING STRUCTURES ON ALA AOLANI STREET IN MOANALUA VALLEY AND OTHER SURROUNDING STREETS DEEMED APPROPRIATE TO DETER SPEEDING.

1 2 3 4 5	WHEREAS, Moanalua Valley is a residential area that is home to several thousand residents and also includes a golf course, neighborhood park, popular hiking trail, and nearby entrance and exit to Interstate H-201; and
5 6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, Ala Aolani Street is the main roadway in the area that is utilized by pedestrians, bicyclists, and resident and visitor drivers; and
10 11 12 13	WHEREAS, many residents in the area have recently expressed concerns about speeding on Ala Aolani Street, which has a speed limit of twenty-five miles per hour; and
13 14 15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, the increase in speeding in the area has increased the risk of harm to drivers, passengers, bicyclists, and pedestrians on other roadways in the area such as Ala Hoku Place; and
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, traffic calming is a method used to regulate speeding by managing the flow of traffic using physical designs and devices, including narrow lanes, speed bumps, speed tables, raised crosswalks and intersections, and roundabouts; and
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, because traffic safety is of paramount importance to residents and visitors alike, implementation of more effective methods of regulating speeding and enforcing speed



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1 limits, including traffic calming systems, is necessary; now, 2 therefore, 3 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 4 5 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, the Senate concurring, that the Department of 6 Transportation, in coordination with the Department of 7 8 Transportation Services of the City and County of Honolulu, is requested to install speed bumps and other traffic calming 9 structures on Ala Aolani Street in Moanalua Valley and other 10 surrounding streets deemed appropriate to deter speeding; and 11 12 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 14 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of 15 Transportation and Director of the Department of Transportation 16 Services of the City and County of Honolulu. 17 18 19 OFFERED BY:

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
