
HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE AUDITOR TO CONDUCT AN AUDIT ON THE DEPARTMENT OF
TRANSPORTATION'S PALI HIGHWAY RESURFACING.

1 WHEREAS, the Pali Highway resurfacing project began in May
2 2017, and was anticipated to be completed in December 2020; and

4 WHEREAS, the project is only approximately seventy-five
5 percent completed; and
6

7 WHEREAS, commuters on Pali Highway are still experiencing
8 lane closures and uneven lanes; and
9

10 WHEREAS, Vineyard Boulevard, Wylie Street, Waokanaka
11 Street, Funchal Street, and Pacific Heights Road still need to
12 be paved; and
13

14 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation estimates the
15 project will be completed in August 2023; and
16

17 WHEREAS, under section 23-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the
18 Auditor may examine and inspect all accounts, books, records,
19 files, papers, and documents, and all financial affairs of every
20 department, office, agency, and political subdivision; and

22 WHEREAS, authorizing the Auditor to examine the Pali
23 Highway resurfacing project may provide residents with timely
24 information on the status of the project; now, therefore,

26 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the
27 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular
28 Session of 2023, that the Auditor is requested to conduct an
29 audit of the Department of Transportation's Pali Highway
30 resurfacing; and


32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of the Auditor is
