## HOUSE RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE HEROES AND PROTECTORS OF O'AHU'S DRINKING WATER.

1	WHEREAS, ola i ka wai means water is life; and
2 3	WHEREAS, the U.S. Navy Red Hill Bulk Fuel Storage Facility
4	stores over 100 million gallons of fuel that sits a mere 100
5	feet above O'ahu's main aquifer, and over the years, the aging
6	tanks have leaked an estimated 180,000 gallons of fuel into
7	O'ahu's natural resources; and
8	
9	WHEREAS, in November 2021, an estimated 19,000 gallons of
10	jet fuel leaked from the aging tanks affecting nearly 100,000
11	residents; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, ERNEST "ERNIE" LAU, chief engineer and manager of
14	the City and County of Honolulu's Board of Water Supply,
15	continues to advocate for the protection of Hawai'i's water
16	supply and publicly supports the O'ahu Water Protectors' efforts
17 18	to pressure the U.S. Navy in light of the 1,100 gallons of highly toxic fire suppressant foam spill in November 2022; and
10 19	highly coxic file suppressant foam spill in November 2022, and
20	WHEREAS, HEALANI SONODA-PALE, the Lead Organizer for the
21	O'ahu Water Protectors, has mobilized volunteers for countless
22	sign waving events, educational campaigns, and peaceful
23	demonstrations over the past 15 months to raise awareness of
24	O'ahu's water crisis; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, WAYNE TANAKA, attorney, engineer, and lifelong
27	environmental advocate, has served as the Executive Director of
28	the Sierra Club of Hawai'i since October 2021; he continues to be
29	steadfast in his efforts to maintain pressure on state and
30	federal agencies to protect O'ahu's precious water resource in
31	this critical moment of history; now, therefore,
