HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO EVALUATE CERTAIN AIEA ROADWAYS AND IDENTIFY OPPORTUNITIES FOR IMPROVEMENT OF TRAFFIC CONDITIONS AND PEDESTRIAN SAFETY.

WHEREAS, drivers who perform illegal U-turns endanger 1 oncoming traffic and pedestrian safety; and 2 3 WHEREAS, illegal U-turns occur at the intersection of 4 Moanalua Road and Kaimakani Street by drivers travelling 5 eastbound on Moanalua Road who wish to travel westbound on the 6 7 same road; and 8 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation's mission 9 includes providing a safe transportation system that ensures the 10 mobility of people and enhances or preserves quality of life; 11 now, therefore, 12 13 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 14 15 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, that the Department of Transportation is 16 requested to evaluate traffic at the: 17 18 (1) Intersection of Moanalua Road and Kaimakani Street; 19 and 20 21 (2) Westbound transition and exit for Highway 99; and 22 23 identify opportunities for improvement of traffic conditions and 24 pedestrian safety, in particular the enforcement of illegal U-25 turns; and 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of 28 Transportation is requested to submit a report of its findings 29 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the 30 Legislature no later than December 31, 2023; and 31 32
