HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE TO EXPAND OR RELOCATE THE POST OFFICE IN PAHOA, HAWAII, TO BETTER SERVE THE NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY.

1	WHEREAS, Pahoa, Hawaii, is a census-designated place in the
2	district of Puna on the island of Hawaii; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, according to the 2020 census, the population of
5	Pahoa is 920 individuals; and
6	
7	WHEREAS, while Pahoa is a small community, the Pahoa post
8	office serves a population of 22,069 residents in the
9	communities of Ainaloa, Fern Acres, Hawaiian Acres, Hawaii
10	Beaches, Hawaiian Paradise Park, Kalapana, Keau, Kurtistown,
11	Leilani Estates, Nanawale Estates, and Orchidland Estates; and
12	
13	WHEREAS, the Pahoa post office has reached its full
14	capacity and can no longer adequately service the Pahoa
15	community or the surrounding areas; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, customers at Pahoa post office often have long
18	wait times to receive service, as the post office is too small
19	to accommodate necessary staff; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, there is not enough parking to serve the many
22	customers that come to do business at the Pahoa post office; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, it is vital for the Pahoa post office to be
25	relocated to a facility that can adequately accommodate the
26	needs of the Pahoa community and where postal service customers
27	can be protected from the weather while they wait in line; now,
