WHEREAS, Civil Beat also reported that the number of 1 2 English learners on track to gaining language proficiency dropped to twenty-eight percent in 2021 and 2022; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the role of teachers play a direct impact on 6 student success; and 7 8 WHEREAS, funding for the English Learner Program should be prioritized by the Department of Education to comply with the 9 10 Civil Rights Act of 1964; now, therefore, 11 12 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 13 Thirty-second Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2023, that the Department of Education is requested 14 15 to prioritize funding for the English Learner Program in public schools to address the increasing population of English learner 16 students in the State; and 17 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 19 20 Resolution be transmitted to the Governor, Chairperson of the Board of Education, and Superintendent of Education. 21 22 23 24
