Award Amount: \$146,322.00

Justification for the establishment of the account or fund: To support operation of the DWI Court Program in the District Court of the First Circuit by enhancing resources available to supervise program participants, increasing training opportunities for program staff, and expanding data collection.

Source of revenue for the fund: National Highway Traffic Safety Administration FAST Act, through Hawai'i DOT CFDA No.: 20.607, 20.608, and 20.616

Appropriation No. S-23-252-J FY 2022 Homeland Security Grant Program Award Amount: \$240,000.00

Justification for the establishment of the account or fund: This grant aims to prevent, deter, respond to, and recover from threats and incidents of terrorism. The goal is to enhance surveillance capabilities and provide enhanced intelligence capabilities at County facilities for the security and protection of employees and general public.
