# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Act 4, First Special Session Laws of Hawaii  
2 2021, is amended by amending section 1 to read as follows:  
3           "SECTION 1. [~~a~~] The department of health may require  
4 the department of education [shall publish a weekly] to report  
5 on [schools that have a student, staff member, or affiliated  
6 individual who has tested positive for] coronavirus disease 2019  
7 [~~(COVID 19)~~]. The report shall include:  
8           (1) ~~The school's name;~~  
9           (2) ~~The date the COVID 19 positive test result was~~  
10           ~~reported to the school; and~~  
11           (3) ~~The date that the positively tested individual was~~  
12 last on the school campus.] case counts and related information  
13 in a manner most appropriate to public health and safety, as  
14 determined by the department of health.  
15           [~~(b) The report shall be published weekly commencing after~~  
16 ~~July 1, 2021, on the department of education's website.] "~~

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
