RELATING TO ELECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to part VIII to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "<u>§11-</u> Digital voter information guide. (a) The office 5 of elections shall prepare, and post on its website, a digital 6 voter information guide. The digital voter information guide 7 shall be posted on the office of election's website in a screen 8 reader-accessible format for voters with special needs who are 9 unable to read standard print due to disability. The office of 10 elections shall provide a translation of the digital voter 11 information guide in Olelo Hawaii on its website. The office of 12 elections shall print and mail a physical copy of the digital 13 voter information guide to any voter upon request. The digital 14 voter information guide shall include: 15 (1) A photograph and short statement of less than one 16 hundred fifty words for each candidate running for 17 public office, to be prepared by the candidate;

3	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
4	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so		
5	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and

7	year 2024-2025 for the office of elections to prepare and mail a		
8	notice to voters that a digital voter information guide may be		
9	found on the office of elections website.		
10	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the office of		
11	elections for the purposes of this Act.
