# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EXPUNGEMENT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 291E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§291E-           First-time offender of operating a vehicle  
5 after consuming a measurable amount of alcohol for persons under  
6 the age of twenty-one years before 1998; expungement. A person  
7 sentenced before July 1, 1998, for a first-time offense of  
8 operating a vehicle after consuming a measurable amount of  
9 alcohol while under the age of twenty-one years, pursuant to  
10 section 291E-64, and who otherwise meets all the requirements of  
11 section 291E-64, may apply to the court for expungement of the  
12 record of conviction for the offense. The court shall issue a  
13 court order to expunge the record of conviction for the offense;  
14 provided that the person has fulfilled the terms of the sentence  
15 imposed by the court. A person granted an expungement of  
16 conviction under this section shall not be eligible for another



1 expungement of conviction under this section or section 291E-  
2 64."

3 SECTION 2. Chapter 706, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
4 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
5 and to read as follows:

6 "§706- First-time property offender before 1998;  
7 probation; expungement. A person sentenced before July 1, 1998,  
8 for a first-time property offense, pursuant to section 706-  
9 622.9, and who otherwise meets all the requirements of section  
10 706-622.9, may apply to the court for expungement of the record  
11 of conviction for the property offense. The court shall issue a  
12 court order to expunge the record of conviction for the property  
13 offense; provided that the person has fulfilled the terms of the  
14 sentence imposed by the court. A person granted an expungement  
15 of conviction under this section shall not be eligible for  
16 another expungement of conviction under this section or section  
17 706-622.9."

18 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.



**Report Title:**

Expungement; Operating a Vehicle After Consuming a Measurable Amount of Alcohol; Property Offenses; Judiciary

**Description:**

Requires courts to, upon application to the court, expunge records of convictions for first-time offenses involving: (1) operating a vehicle after consuming a measurable amount of alcohol while under the age of twenty-one years; and (2) certain property offenses, if the sentencing occurred before 1998. Effective 6/30/3000. (HD1)
