BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103D-303, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (h) to read as follows: In cases of awards made under this section, 3 "(h) non-selected offerors may submit a written request for 4 5 debriefing to the procurement officer within three working days after the posting of the award of the contract. Thereafter, the 6 7 procurement officer shall provide the non-selected offeror a 8 prompt debriefing [-], but shall not disclose any competing 9 offeror's proposal or evaluation score until after any protest 10 is resolved and the contract is executed. Any protest by the non-selected offeror pursuant to section 103D-701 following 11 debriefing shall be filed in writing with the procurement 12 officer within five working days after the date upon which the 13 debriefing is completed." 14

15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 17 begun before its effective date.
