A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE RENEWAL OF DRIVER'S LICENSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 286-107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (c) to read:

4 "(c) Any person who holds a category (1), (2), or (3) 5 license issued under this part [who is unable to appear in 6 person before the examiner of drivers to apply for a renewal of 7 the driver's license,] may [7] apply for a renewal of the 8 driver's license online, by using any electronic or digital 9 means provided by the examiner of drivers, or by mail, if the 10 person is not disqualified from renewing the license under subsection (a) except as provided under subsection (h) [, apply 11 12 for a renewal by mail]. The applicant's request to have the 13 license renewed by mail must be received by the examiner of 14 drivers within ninety days after the expiration of the license 15 or it shall be treated as an application for reactivation of an 16 expired license under section 286-107.5. The examiner of 17 drivers shall, upon receipt of the request, furnish the

1 applicant with all necessary forms and instructions. An 2 application for renewal by mail made pursuant to this subsection 3 shall be accompanied by a statement from a licensed physician, 4 physician assistant, or advanced practice registered nurse 5 certifying that the applicant was examined by the licensed 6 physician, physician assistant, or advanced practice registered 7 nurse not more than [six] three months prior to the expiration date of the applicant's license and that the applicant was found 8 9 by the examination to have met the physical requirements 10 established by the state director of transportation for the 11 renewal of licenses. The application for renewal by mail shall 12 also be accompanied by: 13 (1) A notarized statement of the applicant certifying that 14 the applicant does not possess any valid license to 15 operate the same or similar category or categories of 16 motor vehicles, issued by another licensing authority 17 (unless the license is concurrently surrendered); and 18 (2) [Such] Any other information as may be required by the

examiner of drivers that is reasonably necessary to confirm the identity of the applicant and the
