A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 11-355, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "[+] §11-355[+] Contributions by state and county contractors, subcontractors, contract bidders, applicants for 4 and recipients of grants and subsidies, and their family members 5 6 prohibited. (a) It shall be unlawful for any person who enters 7 into any contract with the State, any of the counties, or any department or agency thereof, or any person who is subcontracted 8 9 under that contract, either for the rendition of personal services, the buying of property, or furnishing of any material, 10 supplies, or equipment to the State, any of the counties, any 11 department or agency thereof, or for selling any land or 12 building to the State, any of the counties, or any department or 13 14 agency thereof, if payment for the performance of the contract or payment for material, supplies, equipment, land, property, or 15 building is to be made in whole or in part from funds 16 appropriated by the legislative body, at any time between the 17

12	[(c)] <u>(f)</u> For purposes of this section[, "completion]:				
13	"Applicant", "recipient", and "person" include members of				
14	boards of directors and officers of an entity making or				
15	soliciting a campaign contribution, or any lobbyist acting on				
16	their behalf.				
17	"Completion of the contract" means that the parties to the				
18	government contract have either terminated the contract prior to				
19	completion of performance or fully performed the duties and				
20	obligations under the contract, no disputes relating to the				



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performance and payment remain under the contract, and all 1 disputed claims have been adjudicated and are final." 2 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 5 begun before its effective date. SECTION 3. Prohibits persons soliciting a state contract, or applicants for or recipients of state grants or subsidies awarded under chapter 42F and their family members from making campaign contributions. Includes subcontractors to a state contract in the prohibition of campaign contributions to a political party, committee, or candidate.
