A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KAIWI COAST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the lands of the
 Kaiwi coast are an invaluable natural asset for the people of
 Hawaii. Numerous community members and organizations have
 fought long and hard over many decades to protect and preserve
 this unspoiled area for future generations, including preserving
 land and working together to establish the Maunalua-Makapuu
 scenic byway.

8 The legislature further finds that a growing interest in 9 this area of Oahu has brought a rapid increase in visitors to 10 the Kaiwi coast. Dangerous conflict between vehicles, 11 pedestrians, and bicyclists along the highway is increasing the 12 risk of injury and death on a regular basis.

13 Collaboration between community organizations and 14 government agencies is necessary to address myriad issues, such 15 as ensuring safety, managing human impacts, preventing invasive 16 species, and restoring the local ecosystem.

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1	Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to enhance the
2	Maunalua-Makapuu scenic byway and protect and preserve the lands
3	of the Kaiwi coast in perpetuity by requiring certain lands to
4	be petitioned to be designated as the Kaiwi coast state park so
5	the area can be properly protected and managed for the benefit
6	of residents and future generations.
7	SECTION 2. (a) The department of land and natural
8	resources shall petition the board of land and natural resources
9	to designate the following tax map key numbers as a state park
10	under the name "Kaiwi coast state park":
11	(1) $(1)3-9-11:002;$ and
12	(2) (1) 3-9-11:007.
13	(b) The department of land and natural resources shall
14	administer the lands in subsection (a) that have been designated
15	by the board of land and natural resources as a state park.
16	(c) This Act shall be exempt from the requirements of
17	section 171-64.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the boundary
18	amendment requirements of chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
19	(d) All conditions and obligations related to federal
20	funds previously expended on lands in subsection (a) shall be
21	observed unless otherwise authorized by the federal government.

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1	SECTION 3. (a) All land within or added to the Kaiwi
2	coast state park shall be considered for designation as
3	conservation land.
4	(b) Land in the Kaiwi coast state park shall be preserved
5	in perpetuity primarily in its wild and natural state.
6	(c) Any land added to the Kaiwi coast state park after the
7	effective date of this Act shall be subject to this section.
8	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
9	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
10	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and
11	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
12	year 2024-2025 for the establishment, planning, and design of
13	the Kaiwi coast state park and Maunalua-Makapuu scenic byway
14	improvements, including safe pedestrian and bicycle
15	connectivity; provided that planning and design shall:
16	(1) Build upon and reflect the direction of recent work on
17	master plans for the Maunalua-Makapuu scenic byway and
18	Kaiwi state scenic shoreline; and
19	(2) Include the department of transportation, department
20	of land and natural resources, city and county of
21	Honolulu, stakeholders who assisted in the creation of

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master plans for the Maunalua-Makapuu scenic byway and
Kaiwi state scenic shoreline, and local community
members who are dedicated to the preservation of the
lands of the Kaiwi state scenic shoreline.
The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.
