RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 279L, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is				
amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated				
and to read as follows:				
"§279L- Parking; regulation. (a) The department of				
transportation may regulate parking utilized by peer-to-peer car				
sharing at state airports.				
(b) The counties may, by ordinance, regulate parking				
utilized by shared cars."				
SECTION 2. Section 431:10C-802, Hawaii Revised Statutes,				
is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:				
"(a) A peer-to-peer car-sharing program shall ensure				
that during each car-sharing period, the shared car [shall				
\underline{be}] \underline{is} insured under a motor vehicle insurance policy that				
[shall provide: provides:				
(1) Primary insurance coverage for each shared car				
available and used through a peer-to-peer car-				
sharing program in amounts $[not]$ no less than

Authorizes the Department of Transportation to regulate the parking of shared cars at state airports. Authorizes the counties to regulate the parking utilized by shared cars. Amends the required coverage for shared cars that are made available through a peer-to-peer car-sharing program during the car-sharing period. Makes permanent peer-to-peer car-sharing insurance requirements. Effective 1/1/2024. (CD1)
