# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 279L, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows: 3 4 **Parking; regulation.** (a) The department of "§279Ltransportation may regulate the parking of shared cars at state 5 6 airports. 7 (b) Each county may, by ordinance, regulate the parking of 8 shared cars on the highways, as defined in section 291C-1, under 9 the county's jurisdiction." 10 SECTION 2. Section 431:10C-802, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 11 is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: 12 "(a) A peer-to-peer car-sharing program shall ensure that during each car-sharing period, the shared car [shall 13 be] is insured under a motor vehicle insurance policy that 14 [shall provide:] provides: 15 16 (1) Primary insurance coverage for each shared car available and used through a peer-to-peer car-17



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1		sharing program in amounts [ <del>not</del> ] <u>no</u> less than
2		[ <del>\$750,000</del> ] four times the amounts set forth in
3		section 431:10C-301(b) for death, bodily injury, and
4		property damage per accident, and costs of defense
5		outside the limits;
6	(2)	Primary insurance coverage for each shared car
7		available and used through a peer-to-peer car-
8		sharing program for personal injury protection
9		coverage that meets the minimum coverage amounts
10		required by section 431:10C-103.5; and
11	(3)	The following optional coverages, which any named
12		insured may elect to reject or purchase, that
13		provides primary coverage for each shared car
14		available and used through a peer-to-peer car-
15		sharing program:
16		(A) Uninsured and underinsured motorist coverages
17		as provided in section 431:10C-301, which shall
18		be equal to the primary liability limits
19		specified in this section; provided that
20		uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage
21		offers shall provide for written rejection of

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1		the coverages as provided in section 431:10C-
2		301;
3	(B)	Uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage
4		stacking options as provided in section
5		431:10C-301; provided that the offer of the
6		stacking options shall provide for written
7		rejection as provided in section 431:10C-301;
8	(C)	An offer of required optional additional
9		insurance coverages as provided in section
10		431:10C-302; and
11	(D)	In the event the only named insured under the
12		motor vehicle insurance policy issued pursuant
13		to this section is the peer-to-peer car-sharing
14		program, the insurer or the peer-to-peer car-
15		sharing program shall:
16		(i) Disclose the coverages in writing to the
17		[ <del>peer-to-peer car-sharing</del> ] <u>shared car</u>
18		driver;
19		(ii) Disclose to the [ <del>peer-to-peer car-sharing</del> ]
20		shared car driver in writing that all
21		optional coverages available may not have

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1		been purchased under sections 431:10C-301
2		and 431:10C-302; and
3	(iii)	Obtain a written acknowledgement from the
4		[ <del>peer-to-peer car-sharing</del> ] shared car
5		driver of receipt of the written
6		disclosures required in paragraphs (1) and
7		(2). The standard disclosure forms used
8		in paragraphs (1) and (2), and every
9		modification of [ <del>such</del> ] forms intended to
10		be used, shall be filed with the
11		commissioner within fifteen days of
12		providing [ <del>such</del> ] <u>the</u> disclosure to the
13		[ <del>peer-to-peer car-sharing</del> ] shared car
14		driver. The insurer or the peer-to-peer
15		car-sharing program shall also send to the
16		[ <del>peer-to-peer car-sharing</del> ] shared car
17		driver every modified disclosure form
18		within fifteen days of the filing of
19		[ <del>such</del> ] <u>the</u> modified disclosure form and
20		comply with paragraph (3). [Such] The

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1	disclosures and acknowledgement may be
2	sent and received by electronic means."
3	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
4	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
5	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on June 30, 3000.

Authorizes the department of transportation to regulate the parking of shared cars at state airports.
