A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
THIRD SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$266,157,361 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the third
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Department of Transportation

8 A. Plans, design, and construction to
9 widen Queen Kaahumanu highway and
10 Kuakini highway between Henry
11 street and Kamehameha III road on
12 the island of Hawaii.

19 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
 20 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
 21 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are



1 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
2 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.

3 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
4 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
5 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

6 (1) The sum appropriated in item 1 shall be expended by
7 the department of transportation;

8 (2) The sums appropriated in item 2 and items 12 through
9 21 shall be expended by the department of education;

10 (3) The sums appropriated in items 3 and 5 shall be
11 expended by the Hawaii health systems corporation;

12 (4) The sum appropriated in item 4 shall be expended by
13 the county of Hawaii; provided that the county of
14 Hawaii provides matching funds on a dollar-to-dollar
15 basis;

16 (5) The sum appropriated in item 11 shall be expended by
17 the department of health;

18 (6) The sum appropriated in item 6 shall be expended by
19 the department of agriculture; and




1 (7) The sums appropriated in items 7 through 10 shall be
2 expended by the department of land and natural
3 resources.

4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
