A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII COLLEGE OF TROPICAL AGRICULTURE AND HUMAN RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the university of 2 Hawaii tuition and fees special fund the sum of \$500,000 or so 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2023-2024 and 4 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 5 year 2024-2025 for the college of tropical agriculture and human 6 resources at the university of Hawaii at Manoa to establish five 7 administrative, professional, and technical full-time equivalent 8 (5.0 APT FTE) positions; provided that the sums appropriated 9 shall be expended as follows:

10 \$100,000 for one administrative, professional, and (1)11 technical full-time equivalent (1.0 APT FTE) extension 12 specialist in entomology in Hilo, county of Hawaii; 13 \$100,000 for one administrative, professional, and (2) 14 technical full-time equivalent (1.0 APT FTE) extension 15 agent in livestock in Hilo, county of Hawaii; 16 (3) \$100,000 for one administrative, professional, and
