A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SEVENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$216,167,709 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2023-2024
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the seventh
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Upcountry Maui Watershed (Maui)

8 A. Plans, land, design, and
9 construction for improvements to
10 the upcountry Maui watershed.

16 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
17 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
18 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
19 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
20 unencumbered as of June 30, 2026, shall lapse as of that date.



1 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
2 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
3 expended for the purposes of this Act as follows:

4 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 4 shall be
5 expended by the department of land and natural
6 resources;

7 (2) The sums appropriated in items 5 through 8 shall be
8 expended by the department of transportation;

9 (3) The sum appropriated in item 9 shall be expended by
10 the department of health; and

11 (4) The sums appropriated in items 10 through 20 shall be
12 expended by the department of education.

13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2023.
